 COUNTY OF KING, STATE OF WASHINGTON, THE FOLLOWING DID OCCUR:

Det. Schultz contacted Det. Martinez, Officer Cordova and I regarding a possible stolen vehicle (2017 Rav4), at the La Quinta Inn located at, 625 6th ST SE, Auburn. Upon contacting the vehicle, the driver who was later positively identified as, Linda Jimmy, fled in the vehicle striking Det. Martinez' vehicle door as he was attempting to exit and struck the front passenger side bumper of Det. Mattson's vehicle. Officer Cordova, Det. Martinez and Det. Mattson activated their emergency light and sirens and began to pursue Linda who was driving the stolen Toyota at a high rate of speed southbound on Auburn Way S. As the stolen vehicle approached the Muckleshoot Casino, Linda drove into the oncoming lanes of traffic, willfully failing and refusing to bring her vehicle to a stop and drove it in a reckless manner in order to elude officers, so Officer's terminated their pursuit. After driving recklessly through traffic and an occupied staffed construction zone, the vehicle was located a short time later stopped near Academy Dr. Linda then began to flee a second time, at which time she struck a parked vehicle and then drove onto northbound Auburn Way S. While driving northbound, Linda intentionally struck Det. Martinez' vehicle head on as he was driving southbound on Auburn Way S, causing extensive damage to his Detective vehicle and disabling it. Linda then drove through the occupied staffed construction zone a second time driving over safety cones and through barricades which were in the road. In order to protect the citizens of Auburn and police officers, a PIT maneuver was used which rendered the stolen Toyota inoperable. Linda was taken into custody along with her boyfriend, Tremaine Daigneault. Post Miranda, Linda admitted to intentionally using the stolen vehicle to strike Officer Martinez's Detective car on both occasions and that she knew the vehicle she was driving was stolen and she apologized for driving what she called, "crazy." She also admitted to knowing her driving put everyone at risk on the road and was said she was, "lucky not to have killed anyone." Based on this information, there was probable cause to arrest her for violating RCW 9a.36.011 Assault 1, RCW 46.61.024 Eluding and RCW 9a.56.068 Possession of Stolen Vehicle.
